Added Ones are → Plasma and Bose-Einstein Condensate



- Plasma: This state consists of super energies and super excited particles. These particles are in the form of ionized gas. These gases get ionized when electricity runs through them. This is used in Neon bulbs or Neon hoardings. It glows with spectral colours according to the nature of the gas. Stars and sun also glow because of the presence of plasma in them. Plasma is created there because of very high temperature.
- Bose-Einstein condensate :In 1920 Indian Physicist Satyendra Nath Bose had done some calculations for the fifth state of matter. Building on his calculations Albert Einstein predicted a new state of matter- the Bose-Einstein condensate [BEC]. In 2001, Eric A. Convell, Wolfgang Ketterle and Carl E. Weiman of USA received the nobel prize for achieving the BEC. It is formed by a cooling gas of extremely low density about 1 hundred thousand of the density of normal air, to supper low temperature.


